| On or before 5 <sup>th</sup> day of class | 30%            | 70%               | June 26 – July 30, 2024    |
| After the 5 <sup>th</sup> day of class    | 0%             | 100%              | On or after July 31, 2024  |

<sup>\*</sup> Last day to drop/withdraw without tuition liability. Offices are closed on weekends. Term Withdrawals are processed based on date received.

This requirement must be adhered to as per the State Education Department (SED).
